The Board of Public Works and Safety met for a regular meeting, Wednesday, August 23, 2006, at 5:00 p.m., in the City Chambers, 3<sup>rd</sup> floor, City Building, Logansport, Indiana.

**Silent Roll Call** was taken. Those present were Deputy Mayor Klinck & Joe Casalini. City Attorney Burns was also present. Mayor Fincher was absent.

**Minutes** of August 16th were accepted as presented on a vote of 2-0.

**New Business:**

- ❖ Code Enforcer Officer Hileman presented her weekly report. The following addresses were recommended to the Board of Public Works and Safety for cleanup action: 133 W. Ottawa, owned by Judy Spencer. The Logansport Street Department will cleanup the property for a cost of \$250.00 per hour, plus a \$50.00 administration fee and a \$50.00 fine. Action against Jeff Murray, 22 W. Ottawa, was taken. Ms. Hileman recommended a \$250.00 fine for being in violation of Ordinance 2004-36, Section 1F, plus \$50.00 administration fine and \$50.00 administration fee; not having a trash tote at a commercial property. Ms. Hileman sent a letter requesting Mr. Murray's presence at the Board of Public Works and Safety, however, he did not reply. This report was accepted on a vote of 2-0.
- ❖ Building Commissioner Hostetler presented his weekly report. His department has collected \$342.00 in various fees during the past week. An updated report was given on property located at 811 W. Linden. Sara Hiatt called the Building Commissioner to explain the pool will be emptied by Thursday, August 24<sup>th</sup> or 25<sup>th</sup>. It was the decision of the Board of Public Works and Safety that she has until the 30<sup>th</sup> of August to comply. The entire report was accepted on a vote of 2-0.
- ❖ A 1985 Chevy Van, Vin # 1GVGG25M4F7126515 was transferred from the Fire Department to the Police Department on a vote of 2-0. The request was made by Fire Chief McMinn.

He has been working on getting the property cleaned up. He has intentions of bringing a building, in sections, onto the property. He questioned if he needs to do anything in way of permits. 
**Board Member Comments:**
