The Board of Public Works and Safety met for a regular meeting, Wednesday, February 1, 2006, at 5:00 p.m., in the City Chambers, 3rd floor, City Building, Logansport, Indiana.


New Business:

- ❖ Code Enforcer Officer Hileman presented her weekly report. This report was accepted on a vote of 2-0.
- ❖ Building Commissioner Hostetler presented his weekly report. His department has collected \$143.00 in various fees during the past week. Property owned by Alice Lincoln, located at 1306 Lobelia Street was declared an unsafe structure. It is judged dangerous as a fire hazard and a hazard to public safety. Ten inspections were completed by Mr. Hostetler, Deputy Mayor Klinck, and Stan Williams, Planning Director. 118 Eel River Ave has been sold. This report and recommendations were accepted as presented on a vote of 2-0.
- ❖ Fire Chief McMinn presented the Fire Department's January report.
- ❖ ArvinMeritor's request to install ten groundwater monitoring wells within the City of Logansport right-of-way along East Miami and North Wall Streets south of Matthew-Warren plant #2 was granted on a vote of 2-0. Andrew Wallace, ERM consultant for ArvinMeritor, was present to answer questions. There has been a contamination problem that needs to be addressed. Mayor Fincher requested of Mr. Wallace to check with Street Commissioner Don Crain on where other test wells are located and not to duplicate drilling sites. Work will begin during the week of February 13th with expectation of finishing within three days.
- ❖ A dumpster request from Nohemi Rennewanz, 1721 Spear Street, from February 6th through February 20th was granted on a vote of 2-0.
