
- ❖ Code Enforcer Officer Hileman presented her weekly report. This report was accepted on a vote of 2-0.
- ❖ Building Commissioner Hostetler delivered his weekly report. His department has collected \$74.00 in various fees during the past week. A letter requesting Alfred and Evelyn Williams, 21 E. Sinclair Place, Shelton, WA. appear before the Board of Public Works and Safety on February 15th to answer questions regarding 118 Eel River Ave property. The Board affirmed the order to raze the garage located at 1126 20th Street on a vote of 2-0. Donetta J and William L. Warner failed to appear to answer questions regarding this structure and its run-down condition. This report and recommendations were accepted as presented on a vote of 2-0.
- ❖ Right-of-Way access was allowed to Astbury Environmental Engineering, Inc., at Logansport MaraMart, 1730 E. Broadway; in order to conduct subsurface investigation to further determine the lateral extent of a petroleum release which occurred at the site.
