- ❖ Code Enforcer Officer Hileman presented her weekly report. The following address (es) is/are recommended for Clean up, to the Logansport Street Department for cleanup at a rate of \$250.00 per hour plus a \$50.00 Administration and \$50.00 fine: The recommendation(s) and entire report is accepted on a vote of 3-0.
- ❖ Building Commissioner Hostetler presented his weekly report. His department has collected \$451.00 in various fees during the past week. His report was accepted as presented on a vote of 3-0.
- ❖ An executive's chair was added to the list of surplus items for sale at the City Auction to be held June 2nd.
- ❖ Arin Zehner, Assistant Planning Director, delivered an updated report on the progress of the Safe Routes to School Project for Franklin and Columbia Schools. The grant is a \$250,000, fully reimbursable from INDOT. The City will appropriate the money, pay the bills and after filling out the forms; receive payment. The construction probably will not start until next year so it will need to be worked into the 2008 budget.
- ❖ The Fire Department was granted special permission to hold a Roadblock in front of the City Building on July 20th & 21st. for the aid of two firemen and the burn fund.


