

On behalf of Cass County Softball League Association, Dave Hardin requested permission to run an all night softball tournament for the league as a fund raiser. The plan is to play 7 games on June 19<sup>th</sup>, starting at 5:00 p.m. running until 11:00 p.m. Games would start again at 5:00 a.m., Saturday June 20<sup>th</sup>, and play on thru Sunday June 21, with the last game to begin at 8:00 p.m. Sunday night. The park board members have granted their permission for use of the facilities. Permission was granted on a vote of 2-0.

Mayor Fincher read the Proclamation recognizing the Eel River Indian Tribe for their years of public service. Indian Chief Mike Floyd encouraged public participation May 23<sup>rd</sup>. and 24<sup>th</sup> at France Park, for the gathering of drums. He stated that this event is held in only a few locations around the country.
