Code Enforcer Officer Hileman is on vacation.


Building Commissioner Hostetler delivered his weekly report. The department has collected \$1,403.00 in various fees during the past week. Twelve citizens ordered to appear for violations of the garage sale permit and sign Ordinance. One person paid in advance of the hearing. Six fined \$10.00 for not getting a license. Those in violation of the sign violation were given warning not to do so again. The remaining number was "No Shows". There is not a consensus on how to handle the "No Shows". Sonja Long, owner of the Tipton School property, has until the end of this month to comply with order to clean up the property or it will be settled in court. Mr. Hostetler said he spoke with the insurance agent about the Ponderosa fire/clean up. He was told they are in arbitration with the settlement of the insurance.
