New Business:

- Code Enforcement Officer Hileman presented her department's weekly report. The following address (es) is (are) recommended for the Logansport Street Department for cleanup at a rate of \$250.00 per hour, \$75.00 landfill fee, plus a \$50.00 Administration and \$50.00 fine:-0-. An additional eleven properties placed on Continuous Order on properties to mow, list has 250 such properties.
- Building Commissioner Hostetler's weekly report was delivered by Mayor Fincher. The department has collected \$1,338.00 in various fees during the past week. The finding of facts and entire report were affirmed on a vote of 3-0.


