The Board of Public Works and Safety met for a regular meeting, Wednesday, June 22, 2011, at 9:00 a.m., in the City Chambers, 3rd floor, City Building, Logansport, Indiana.

New Business:

- Code Enforcement Officer Hileman presented her department's weekly report. The following address (es) is (are) recommended for the Logansport Street Department for cleanup at a rate of \$250.00 per hour, \$75.00 landfill fee, plus a \$50.00 Administration and \$50.00 fine: Maria & Claudio Montalvo, 221 Ottawa and Marcelino Sanchez, 712 W. Broadway. Ten property addresses have been added to the Continuous Order to mow for a total of 260. The finding of facts and entire report were affirmed on a vote of 3-0.
- Building Commissioner Hostetler delivered his weekly report. The department has collected \$1,356.00 in various fees during the past week. Conditional Certificate of occupancy issued to All Saints Parish Hall at 112 E. Market Street and any Time Fitness, 4903 E. Market Street. Property located at 1010 North Street deemed as an Unsafe Structure. Action on property located at 2311 Spear Street was continued to July 6th. The Unsafe Structure was lifted on property located at 703 Bringham. Three property owners were excused from fines for violation of Yard Sign Placement. Jan Newton on behalf of Business and Professional Women Club, was given a pass as her group is a 501-C. Properties located 210 Bigler and 1902 George Street, first time offenders and given a pass. Joe Dunn provided a report on his property that sold at a Commissioners' Tax Sale. The buyer of that property has Joe's permission to start rehabbing that property as soon as they wish. Joe will stay in communication with the Building Commissioner. The finding of facts and entire report were affirmed on a vote of 3-0.
- Fire Chief Bernie Mittica submitted activity report for the month of May for the fire department.
- Jan Fawley, Parks Administrator, submitted request for a road closure and waiver of noise ordinance during the "FanFest" on Thursday, June 30 from 5-7 p.m. at Riverside Park. A map of activities provided. Request granted on a vote of 3-0.

- Jan Fawley, Parks Administrator, submitted request for waiver of noise ordinance for July 4th Festivities. Regarding parking, Special Officers, led by Dale Turnpaugh, will direct traffic and parking. It is encouraged to walk to the park for this event. Fireworks will start around 10:00 P.M. from the Logansport Municipal Utilities pole yard on the North side of the Eel River. Both entrances to River Bluff Trail & Hervey Preserve Trail will be closed. A map was provided.
- Clerk Treasurer Bland submitted permission to hold the Annual City Auction on Friday, July 1, at 6:00 p.m. behind the City Building. A 15% commission to be paid to Terry Rogers Auctioneer, plus the costs of advertisement. A list of items presented to the Board of Public Works and Safety and deemed surplus property, available for sale. Permission granted on a vote of 3-0.


