Logan's Landing

Commercial Facade Improvement Program

Eligible Projects: exterior paint, awning, exterior lighting, front facade windows, brick facade, and facade maintenance/restoration

Award: 50% of project up to \$5,000

Applicants: Must be within Downtown

Timing: applications reviewed monthly



Logansport Redevelopment Commission

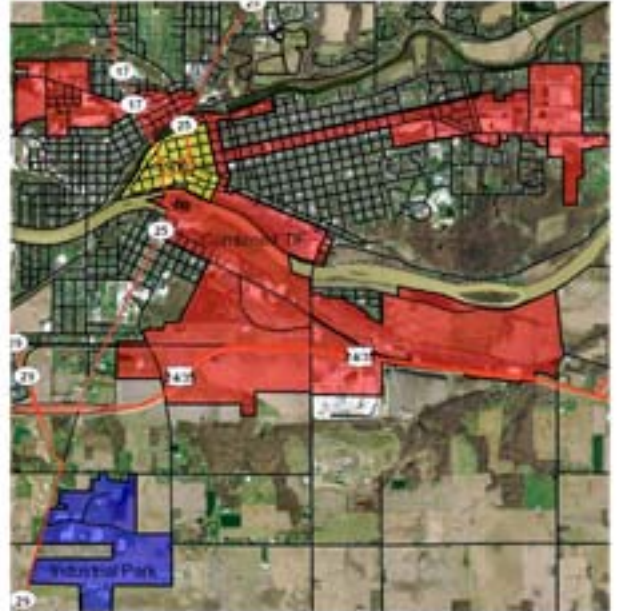
Exterior Improvement Program

Eligible Projects: exterior doors and windows, painting, shutters, awnings, signs, stairs, porches, railing, exterior walls, roofs, walkways/sidewalk, lighting, and repair/replacement of parking lot

Award: 15% of project up to \$250,000

Applicants: Must be within a TIF District

Timing: applications reviewed monthly



Commercial Use Sidewalk/Curbing Program

Eligible Projects: sidewalk, curbing, and gutters

Award: 50% of project up to \$5,000

Applicants: Must be within a TIF District

Timing: applications reviewed monthly

Office of Community and Rural Affairs

Main Street Revitalization Program (MSRP)

Eligible Projects: facade renovations (*building fronting on any street*), and streetscape

Award: 80% of project cost

Applicant: City with Cwner's Consent

Timing: 2 rounds a year (from award to completion may be 18months+)

Historic Renovation Grant Program (HRGP)

Eligible Projects: roof, windows, doors, brick work, foundation, rehab of Architectural Characteristics

Award: 35% of the total project up to \$100,000 including match

Applicants: on National Registry or could be, and could be used for commercial purposes

Timing: applications reviewed monthly (currently out of funding)
